
# Japanese Immersion Preschool 2025 Registration




## **PRIORITY GROUP ORDER**

   \*Children who have participated the JLC infant/Toddler programs in the current year or the previous year for more than a full term and the siblings of JLC preschool graduates are given a priority over new students.

#### **IMPORTANT NOTES**

- ✓ **Full-Day students** have **priority** to register over the Half-day students.
- ✓ The **3-5 days/week students** have **priority** to register over the 2days/week students.
- ✓ All parent fees above are subject to change along with the government funding policies.
- ✓ The admission requirements differ from family to family, depending on child's language environment and the frequency of classes per week.
- ✓ If the requirements are not met or a student has difficult time following the Japanese Only policy, the student may be asked to withdraw from the program.
